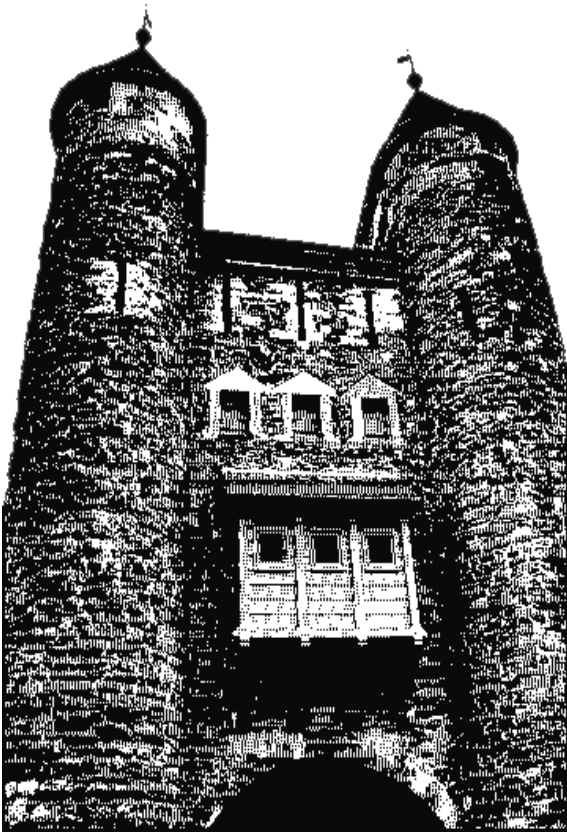


# Actions of the Lowe Countries: The Siege of Maastricht

## 2 Schedule of Events

### 2.1 Friday

Opening day will primarily be dedicated to camp layout, event registration, informal introductions, and optional workshops. The Tavern will be serving a light supper, but participants are welcome to prepare their own meals, if they are so equipped. Costumes are encouraged, and required for participation in the workshops and entrance to the Tavern.

There will be a general meeting late in the day for group captains and event organizers, exact time to be announced.

- **1:00 – 2:30 PM (1 hour 30 min):** New Recruit orientation and artillery demonstration
- **2:30 -3:30 PM (1 hour):** Sword workshop conducted by Christopher Uchman-Douglas
- **4:00 - 5:00 PM (1 hour):** New musketeer training and weapons inspection
- **5:00 – 6:00 (1 hour):** Supper served in the Tavern
- **6:00 – 7:00 PM (1 hour):** Rules of Engagement (strongly suggested for all soldiers)
- **Evening (time to be announced)** Lecture on Siege Warfare and the Siege of Maastricht

## **2.2 Saturday**

- **6:30 – 7:30AM (1 hour):** Reveille, breakfast issue (Reveille Drum Cadence)  
All rise, dress, and take their morning meal (provided).
- **7:30 – 8:00 AM (30 min):** General Assembly (Form-up Drum Cadence)  
Soldiers and camp assemble for welcome and general instructions, and for the Admonition before the Musters. Parade and Salute the Colours. (Parade Colours Drum Cadence)
- **8:00 – 8:15 AM (15 min):** March from camp to drill & shooting area along main road
- **8:15 - 9:15 AM (1 hour):** Separate - pike postures and basic musketry
- **9:15 - 10:15 AM (1 hour):** Basic distances, facings and motions (Form-up Drum Cadence).  
This drill is for all Foote soldiers, with their armes (both Pike and Shot). Training will be in formation for distances, facings, and motions.
- **10:15 – 10:30 AM (15 min):** All participants take break in the field. Campfollowers to provide refreshment to the soldiers.
- **10:30 - 11:15 AM (45 min):** Beyond the basics for motions & facings.
- **11:15 - 11:30 AM (15 min):** March back to camp.
- **11:30 AM – 1:00 PM (1.5 hours):** Mid-day meal and sword workshop (Disband Drum Cadence). All participants return to camp to partake in the mid-day meal (dinner)
- **1:00 - 1:15 PM (15 min):** March from camp to drill & shooting area.
- **1:15 - 2:30 PM (1 hour 15 min):** Separate - pike motions refined and live fire training for muskets at the shooting range.
- **2:30 - 2:45 PM (15 min):** All participants take break in the field. Campfollowers to provide refreshment to the soldiers. (Disband Drum Cadence)
- **2:45 - 3:30 PM (1 hour 15 min):** Advanced combined arms (Form-up Drum Cadence)
- **3:30 - 4:15 PM (45 min):** Tactical (Form-up Drum Cadence)
- **4:15 - 4:30 PM (15 min):** March back to camp then parade and lodge the colours (Parade Colours Drum Cadence).
- **4:30 PM:** – Retreat (Retreat Drum Cadence). Field events concluded for the day
- **5:00 – 10:30 PM:** Supper and evening activates  
Tavern open  
Prepare and take your evening meal  
Full meals available from camp cooks, (supper served at 5:00 PM)  
Relax, game, dance, and imbibe (prudently)
- **10:30 PM:** Last Call  
Tavern closed (at the discretion of the Tavern Keeper and the Provost).
- **11:00 PM:** Tattoo (Tattoo Drum Cadence).  
All participants return to their quarters. Watch and Ward duty begins.

## **2.3 Sunday**

- **7:30 – 8:30AM (1 hour):** (On this Feast Day of St. George, the Colonel has granted camp a one hour lie-in.) Reveille, breakfast issue (Reveille Drum Cadence).  
All rise, dress, and take their morning meal (provided).
- **8:30 – 9:00 AM (30 min):** General Assembly, Divine Services (Form-up Drum Cadence).  
Soldiers and camp assemble for general instructions and to participate in Divine Service. Parade and Salute the Colours. (Parade Colours Drum Cadence).
- **9:00 - 9:15 AM (15 min):** March from camp to drill & shooting area
- **9:15 - 10:15 AM (1 hour):** Separate: pike, close combat & final assaults, and musketry (optional live fire)
- **10:15 – 10:30 AM (15 min):** Morning Break in the field. Campfollowers to provide refreshment to the soldiers.
- **10:30 – 11:15 AM (45 min):** Combined arms, review.
- **11:15 - 11:30 AM (15 min):** March back to camp.
- **11:30 AM – 1:00 PM (1 hour 30 min):** Mid-day meal (Disband Drum Cadence).  
All participants return to camp to partake in the mid-day meal (dinner). Some optional workshops may be available.
- **1:00 - 1:15 PM (15 min):** March from camp to drill & shooting area along a narrow foot trail, necessitating forming one file.
- **1:15 - 2:30 PM (1 hour 15 min):** Tacticals.
- **2:30 - 3:30 PM (1 hour):** Final review at the drill field, march back to camp, lodge the colors.
- **3:30 PM:** Event Concluded (Retreat Drum Cadence).
